DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Sunny Side is located in the development called Traveller's Rest, south of Kirkham and on a silted inlet of the Tred Avon River. The house is composed of three main parts, all small in size and scale. In the center is the larger of the three parts, which is a two bay long, one and one-half story frame building with east chimney emerging from the roof of the east wing. On the first floor facade are three windows, but there was probably a central door originally. Two dormers on each side of the 'A' roof light the second story rooms. Around at least one of the windows of the first story is original trim with ovolo backband.

Adjoining the main part, on the east side is a lower one and one-half story wing containing the main entrance which is a mid-19th century piece having sidelights and transom. There are two windows east of the door and two dormers, all with 6/6 sash.

On the opposite side of the taller section is a one story wing built in the twentieth century and on the extreme east end is a flat roof kitchen area.

Inside most of the original work has been removed or covered. The mantel in the large living room is original except for the top of the shelf and added pilasters. The stair is now located in the southwest corner, but the living room was probably two rooms originally and the stair may have been located elsewhere. This cannot be determined at present.

Ceiling joists are exposed in the dining room, which was the original kitchen. All other original work has been either removed or covered.


