Circa 1810; circa 1850

Deep Neck consists of a three-bay, two-and-one-half-story brick house probably built circa 1800 by the Skinner Family, to which was added in about 1850 a five-bay two-and-one-half-story frame addition. The entire structure has been painted in order to provide unity. The brick section has Flemish bond on the main facades, but lacks a water table and beltcourse. It nevertheless has a number of noteworthy interior features, including six-panel doors, period mantels, and the original flooring and staircase.
