DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Grace Creek Rarm is located south of Bozman overlooking the confluence of Grace and Leadenham Creeks into Broad Creek. The house faces southeast and was a typical early nineteenth century frame dwelling found in the outter reaches of Talbot, Dorchester and Caroline Counties. It is composed of a two bay long, one and one-half story section with single bay addition.

The central entrance of the northwest facade has a porch protecting the 1840's six panel door. On each side is a single window with 6/6 sash and louvered shutters. Two dormers light the rooms above. Within the gables rise two brick chimneys. On the northeast gable of the house is a small addition with door and window on the facade and one dormer above. These two sections complete the early part of the dwelling. Subsequently, however, seven other additions were made to the house creating a very long low dwelling with a glass room across the water front of the house.

The interior was originally three rooms, two in the taller part and one in the wing. There were also rooms above. Presently there is one large room in the main part. On the southwest wall of the room is vertical beaded board paneling, a fireplace and enclosed stair. The opposite side of the room has another fireplace with cabinets on each cheek.

Adjoining the fireplace in the former kitchen is also a small stair.

Grace Creek Farm is significant as a small early 19th century frame vernacular structure which still retains much of its original fabric although the southeast side of the roof has been removed and rebuilt.

On the 1877 Atlas the property is listed in the possession of W. Camper.




