DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Elberton is an interesting 1½ story frame dwelling which appears to date from the early 19th Century. It presently consists of a tall central section with two lower wings of nearly equal size. It appears that the east wing is original and the west was added during the 20th Century. On each section of the building the dormers have been connected by a shed roof addition covered with roof shingles which creates additional headroom while still maintaining the appearance of the 1½ story house.
