DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The store building is a two story frame structure, two bays wide and two deep. It stands so close to the ground that the foundation is not visible. The walls are covered with German siding. On the first story is a central double entrance door flanked by a window on each side. A small, one bay leanto addition with false front is appended to the south side of the building. Across the three principle bays is a hip roof porch supported on brackets. The windows are closed with shutters; on the addition the shutters have a diagonal iron bar across the shutters. On the second story, the windows have 6/6 sash and louvered shutters.

On the north side of the building is another addition, part of which is two story. There is a distinct lean to the north where the ground is higher and where the sill has rotted. An overhanging eave extends around the building.

The Longwoods Store is included in the survey of historic sites because it is a type building which was very common in our towns and villages prior to the advent of the great chain stores and ease of transportation by the masses. Architecturally, it is similar to the Woolford Store and post office, Dorchester County. It is a plain structure of the late 19th century but represents a way of life which has passed.
