DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

St. Paul's M.E. Church is located on the east side of Cordova Road adjacent the new school. It is a typical late 19th century frame ecclesiastical structure, three bays deep and three bays wide with a tower entrance. The windows have lancet arches, as does the entrance with its double doors and transom. Above the entrance is a round window. Above the apex of the main roof with its juncture with the tower, the tower is hipped into the open bellfry which has two lancet arches on each side with balustrade between. A pyramidal roof with short finial covers the bellfry. The entire building is supported on a brick foundation and the walls are covered with asbestos siding.




