Scott's M.E. Church stands 10' from Main Street in the village of Trappe. The church faces west. This structure was built in 1886. The church measures 34' across the front and is 46' in depth. Scott's ME Church is the oldest black church in the village of Trappe. Trappe has an old black community. This village is the scene of a 4th of July Celebration that celebrates black emancipation. A number of blacks from the Trappe vicinity served in the Civil War. This church has long been used by black Republicans in this area for meetings and has a noble history in the struggle for Civil Rights and black political advancement.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Scott's M.E. Church stands 10' from Main St. in the village of Trappe. The church faces west. This structure was built in 1886 and faces west. The church measures 34' across the front and is 46' in depth. The church is built of weatherboard and painted grey. There is short tower with an open belfry with a graceful spire atop located on the northeast corner of the building. The building is gable-ended (east-west). The entrance has three concrete steps that rise to double wooden doors. There is a cathedral window (colored-glass) in the front facade. There are four lancet windows (6') colored-glass (blue) on the north and three identical windows on the south side of the building. The roof is covered with composite shingles.








(CAMBRIDGE) CAMBRIDGE 5 MI. VIENNA 20 MI. 2'30"
