This house is 'L' shaped. The front facade, facing north along the street has a two story 3 bay portion with a gable roof with asphalt shingles and a chimney on the ridgepole inside the west gable. To the west or right of this gable is a one story addition, gabled roof covered with asphalt shingles and walls covered with asbestos shingles. The front or street facade has a 2/2 double-hung window in the center of the wall. The gable end of this portion has a window at the middle covered with two panel louvered shutters. To the right of this window is a smaller one of 4 panes the top of which is at the level of the neighboring window and the bottom mid-height on the bigger window. The roof facing the back of this section extends to enclose a shed.

The 2 story portion of the house has a gabled ell whose ridgepole points south. This ell is two stories high and has a brick chimney at the center of its south gable. This ell is also covered with white asbestos shingles.

According to Otis Bridges the ~~sheathing~~ on the roof is probably 6-8" wide tongue and groove .



STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE:

This house was built by Aunt Flora Rideout's son. He had built one in the early 1900's. It was struck by lightning and burned. This is the second house he built on the same property. This house probably has lapped weatherboard for siding which later was covered with asbestos siding for making it weather tight. Otis Bridges laughed when he talked about the weather tight quality of the old houses, claiming he had seen the linoleum on the kitchen floor rise a foot in the air when a big wind blew. It was later sold to "Buck" Charles Phillips.






