DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Knotts Farm, located in the northeast corner of Talbot County near the town of Queen Anne, is a rare survival of a late 19th century frame Italianate style farmhouse. Like many of the houses of the period in this area, the Knotts Farm is composed of two major portions, the main block and the 'L' to the rear of one south side. Its two story facade is five bays long with three bay one story porch. The central door has sidelights and transom and is similar to the three-part window above, however, above the window is a plain pediment repeating the outline of the gable in the 'A' roof. Windows on both storys have 4/4 sash although the upper sash are smaller. A wide cornice overhangs the house on all sides and is supported by shaped brackets. At the gable ends are two brick chimneys with small recessed panels in each side, similar to Memory Lane, Caroline County.

The four bay 'L' is devoid of ornamentation and has a small porch on its north side. North of the porch is a smokehouse.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Knotts Farm is one of the few dwellings of the period which have survived with little alteration to the exterior ornamentation. The brackets of both the roof and later porch are noteworthy as examples of the plainer sort of house frequently built in the second half of the 19th century.


