Prepare both a summary paragraph and a general description of the resource and its various elements as it exists today.

The J.B.Harrison house, or Reluctant Point, is located at the end of Gibsontown Road in the village of Tilghman on Tilghman Island, Talbot County, MD. The house faces south, with the principal gable oriented on an east/west axis.

Built in 1881, this frame two-and-a-half story house is clad in white cedar shake shingles and the roof is covered with unpainted cedar shake shingles. The brick pier foundation has been infilled with concrete blocks.

The south (main) facade has five bays with a central door flanked by two three-over-one sash windows. The six-panel door has a classical surround and a flat roof portico supported by ionic columns. The second story of the south facade has five three-over-one sash windows and there are three cross gables at the attic story. Pointed-arch windows are inset into these gables which also have decorative bracket work.

The east elevation gable end has an exterior brick chimney and two quarter-round windows at the attic story. There is one colored glass window on the south side of the chimney at the first floor.

The north (rear) elevation has a full-width shed roof addition roofed with asphalt shingles. A screened porch was built onto the western bays of the addition around 1975. The second story of the northern elevation has three three-over-one sash windows. There is an interior brick chimney at the northwest corner of the primary wing.

The west elevation gable end has two three-over-one sash windows on the first story and two vents at the attic story. There is an entrance door and a pair of four light casement windows on the west side of the shed addition.

The interior banister rail is a solid piece of wood. This interior architectural feature reflects skills J.B.Harrison used later in his boat building career. A two seater outhouse remains in the backyard of the property.

Prepare both a summary paragraph of significance and a general statement of history and support.

The J.B.Harrison house, named Reluctant Point by its current owners, was built in 1881 by J.B.Harrison at the age of 16. Some of the wood for the structure came from Bald Eagle Point which Harrison transported himself by canoe. According to his daughter, Harrison's father was building a boat within sight of the house while J.B. worked on his house. The elder Mr. Harrison instructed the young J.B. as he worked. Later, J.B.Harrison built the house to the west of Reluctant Point.

J.B. Harrison went on to become one of Tilghman Island's most renowned boat builders. Most of his boat building was carried out on Devil's Island, an island built of oyster shells and connected by a causeway to Gibsontown Road. The remains of this island can still be seen, although much of it was destroyed in the hurricane of 1933. Today, the J.B.Harrison house has been exposed to the public eye via the watercolor paintings of the nationally published artist Susan Davis. Davis lives in the neighboring house built by Harrison.

The Harrison house has a cross gable dormer arrangement similar to the no longer extant Faulkner Boarding House in Fairbank. It is one of the more outstanding buildings on Gibsontown Road, significant both because of its design and its well-known designer in wood, J.B.Harrison.


