DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Hunting Hall is located on the bank of Hunting Creek and at the end of a lane off of Marengo Road approximately one mile south of Gregory Road in Talbot County. The house was built in the early twentieth century and in the Colonial Revival style.

Hunting Hall is frame on a brick foundation and has exterior clapboards painted white. It has a gambrel roof and a single exterior brick chimney stack on the south end. The main section is two and one-half storys and five by two bays. The main facade faces west and has a central entrance with a segmental door frame and a fanlight. Other bays on this facade and on the sides have six-over-six sash windows and black louvered shutters. There are gabled dormers on the slate roof.

The south side has a one story, columned and screened-in porch with a balustrade roof. A one and one-half story service wing with an arcade porch is attached to the north side. The east side has a modern brick patio.

The interior plan has a central hall with large single rooms to each side. The rooms have high ceilings and are brightly lit from large amount of window space.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Hunting Hall is of interest to the survey of old and historic houses in Talbot because it is built in the Colonial revival style which was so prevalent in the county during the first four decades of the twentieth century. The structure retains most of its original fabric and detailing which is seen infrequently in more recent structures.


