DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Still Waters is located on the southernmost part of Miles River Neck overlooking the waters of Hunting Creek and across the creek from Hunting Hall.

The house is a late Federal style frame dwelling constructed upon a brick foundation. Like Wye Heights and Presquile, the facade is the gable, with central entrance having sidelights and transom flanked by two windows. Three symmetrical windows light the second story. In the gable is a small round window with four pane sash. Along the overhanging eave are scrolled brackets. Across the entire facade is a one story porch of simple design. Two chimneys rise from the sides of the house.

On the northeast side of the house is a small two story kitchen wing one bay long, with a shed addition. On the opposite side is a partly screened, partly enclosed porch, with long windows to the floor for easy access to the interior. The northwest gable has only two windows on each story. All of the windows, with the exception of the long ones on the porch, have 6/6 sash and louvered shutters.

The interior plan is like Riverslie before the additions, and similar to Pleasant Valley, a much earlier building. It consists of an entrance/stair hall in the east corner of the building, a den in the south corner, a living room in the west corner and dining room in the north corner, with the kitchen in the wing.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Still Waters is important as a mid 19th century farmhouse similar to Riverslie. It is of interest that both buildings have the same plans and details and that the plan is so similar to Pleasant Valley, the house which appears to have been the prototype for the plan in Talbot.


