DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Although more substantial and self-contained, 125-127 North Locust Street is a visual extension of the row of houses, 111-123 North Locust. Built on a stone base, this brick house is symmetrically fenestrated into six bays, the doorways set to one side (third member of each group of three bays, presently a double house). All windows are shuttered and all have splayed brick lintels; 125 has 2/2 windows, while 127 has 1/1 -- originally all would have been 6/6. The first floor windows are proportionately taller than those on the second floor. There is a simple cornice across the front. There is a large ell attached to this rectangular block in the middle of the rear.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Include Personages, Dates, Events, Etc.)

125-127 North Locust Street is a handsome brick house dating from the late Federal to the Greek Revival period. Its original facade has been altered by later doors and by replacing the 6/6 window mullions. With its neighbors to either side, this house is part of an almost complete block of early to mid 19th century urban dwellings.
