Property Name/Address: "Cynosure," 1016 Potomac Ave., Hagerstown, Maryland

Description/Significance: A very large two story L-shaped brick house with bracketed cornice, segmental-arched window heads, porte-cochere, and two-story gallery across part of the facade, reflecting the Italian Villa influence of the third quarter of the nineteenth century. The principal facade faces east, and comprises a gable front main block four bays wide, with a wing extending to the north. A one story verandah spans the main block, supported on square posts. The entrance, located in the second bay from the north, features sidelights and transom set in a segmental-arched opening. The remaining bays of the first floor hold large 6/6 windows with operable paneled shutters. On the second story, two 6/6 sash are fitted with louvered shutters. All the window openings are segmental-arched. The peak of the gable holds a louvered vent flanked by small narrow sash. The overhanging cornice is supported on scrolled brackets. A two story wing spanned by a gallery projects from the north side of the main block. The house is set well back from the street, and predates the subdivision of the surrounding area.


