<p>6-8 South Potomac Street in Hagerstown, Washington County, stands on the east side of the street in the block formed by Public Square and Antietam Street.</p> <p>The building is an early-mid nineteenth century brick structure which was extensively remodeled in the twentieth century. Originally two and a half stories high, the building is now two stories in height and has a flat roof. The street facade (west side) was covered with masonry imitation brick in the 1970s. The first floor of the facade has an arched doorway on the north end, a glass block square window in the center, and a small shop front on the south end. With the possible exception of the arched doorway, no original features of the facade exist. The outline of the gable roof is visible on the neighboring buildings.</p>




