DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

130 South Potomac Street is quite similar to 28-30 East Franklin Street in that it is a three storey (2 plus mansard) brick house on a stone base and which has two bowed projections at the second floor level flanking a central bay which has a Flemish gable-dormer at attic level. In addition to the Flemish gable mentioned, the end walls of the mansard roof in the front have stepped gables, also a Flemish feature. The other ornamentation is Romanesque and consists of floriated bases of the second storey bows and similar floriated blocks terminating the Romanesque arch over the entrance doorway.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Include Personages, Dates, Events, Etc.)

An example of imaginative speculative building, 130 South Potomac Street with its simple Romanesque details, offers a varied and handsome street facade. The contrasts of dark brick and white trim, coupled with the unifying feature of gray slate roof, stone base and window lintels, makes for a bright and exuberant, yet restrained urban block. Romanesque arch of dorrway echoes use of similar arches on St. John's Lutheran Church apse across the street.
