DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

60-62 West Washington Street in Hagerstown, Washington County, stands on the north side of the street near the center of the block formed by Public Square and Jonathan Street.

The building is a two stories high masonry commercial structure with an Art Deco influenced facade (south side). It sits tight to the sidewalk and neighboring buildings and has a run of large display windows and a set of double doors on the street level. The second floor of the facade is a blank wall bearing a large sign stating the name of the business. The facade is constructed of smooth surfaced rectangular masonry blocks and is capped by convex banding.

The building appears to be structurally sound and basically original in condition on the facade.


