DESCRIPTION:

This house is a circa early 1920s stuccoed masonry stylistically eclectic structure which stands on the north side of West Irvin Street between Oak Hill Avenue and Hamilton Boulevard. The house is a large one and a half stories high with steeply pitched gable roofs, metal casement windows, a recessed entrance with thick fluted round columns supporting a segmental arched pediment. Above the recessed entrance is a dormer with a broad segmental arch roof line. The roof is covered with asphalt shingles and is rolled at the edges creating a thatched-roof effect. The structure rests on a stone foundation. A one story garage, probably constructed much later than the house, projects from the west side of the house.

The interior was not inspected.

SIGNIFICANCE:

This house was probably built about the early 1920s. The present owner acquired the property in 1971 (Deed Book 523), p. 281) from the estate of Fannie G. Reichard who with her husband, John L. Reichard, purchased it in 1925 (Deed Book 170, p. 684). The house stands in the north end of Hagerstown which was developed in the first third of the twentieth century as a professional class residential neighborhood.


