
Property Name/Address: Washington County Museum of Fine Arts, City Park, Hagerstown, Maryland

Description/Significance: A finely detailed brick Neoclassical building designed by architects Hyde & Shepherd of New York and constructed in 1931. Wings added in 1949 are sympathetic to the original design. The museum reflects a noteworthy commitment of public support to the fine arts.


