
Property Name/Address: 523 Jefferson St., Hagerstown, Maryland

Description/Significance: A small one story, three bay house, constructed of brick on a raised stone foundation. Form and detailing indicate a mid-19th century date. The rear slope of the gable roof has a slight curve or "kick," possibly indicating Germanic influence. Representative of the smaller type of early residential building in Hagerstown; several houses, similar in form but constructed of various materials, are located in the next block of Jefferson Street to the west, within the pending Hagerstown Historic District.
