
Property Name/Address: 1201 Hamilton Blvd., Hagerstown, Maryland

Description/Significance: A turn of the 20th century frame house with irregular massing, heavy Tuscan porch columns, and a multicolor slate roof, reflecting the influence of the Shingle Style; larger in scale and earlier in date than neighboring properties.
