
Property Name/Address: 343 Central Ave., Hagerstown, Maryland

Description/Significance: ca. 1840 two story, five bay brick house with recessed two story, two bay gallery, Greek Revival-influenced transom and entrance surround. Reflects rural vernacular building traditions of the area; the two-story recessed porch is a particularly noteworthy feature, typical of Washington and Frederick counties in the period. Surrounded by dense late 19th-early 20th century residential development; predates subdivision of the West End.
