
Property Name/Address: Zeller Apartments, southeast corner Hill Crest Road and Dewey Avenue, Hagerstown, Maryland

Description/Significance: A highly eclectic turn of the 20th century brick apartment building, primarily reflecting the influence of the Colonial Revival in its exuberant decorative detailing. The building stands three stories high at street level; a sloping grade allows for an additional full story at the basement level. Massing and fenestration are irregular, and a separate entrance is provided for each apartment. Most apartments also have their own porches or terraces. Its residential scale reflects the character of the surrounding neighborhood, and distinguishes the building from other apartment blocks of the period in Hagerstown.
