
Property Name/Address: 117 East Franklin St., Hagerstown, Maryland

Description/Significance: A ca. 1890 three story brick townhouse, three bays wide, with Colonial Revival detailing. The entrance is located in the easternmost bay, and is detailed with a rectangular transom with tracery imitating a fanlight. Window openings have stone lintels and are fitted with 6/1 sash. The second story features a three-sided oriel above the entrance. The building is capped with an overhanging modillioned cornice. There is a projecting bay on the west side elevation.
