
Property Name/Address: 113-115 East Franklin St., Hagerstown, Maryland

Description/Significance: A ca. 1890 Italianate influenced three story duplex, constructed of brick which has been painted. The six-bay facade comprises two three-bay units, with entrances located in the two central bays. Facade openings are segmental arched with decorative hoods of projecting brick. Windows are 1/1 sash. A bracketed cornice caps the facade, above a frieze with rectangular vents detailed with decorative metal grilles.
