Description:

Built after the completion of the 1911 Sanborn Insurance Map for Hagerstown, this building is a three story, eight bay hip roofed structure located adjacent to the former tracks of the Western Maryland Railway. It is of brick construction with stone foundations. Windows have segmentally arched heads and two over two light sash. First story windows on the Church Street facade have been enlarged and infilled with glass blocks, probably in the 1950s. A central horizontal corbeled panel beneath the third story windows carried signage for the building. A loading dock and railroad tracks are still visible along the west side of the building.

Significance:

Dating from the early 20th century, this industrial structure is one of a group of such buildings constructed along the rail lines on the west side of Hagerstown. With direct access to the Western Maryland Railway, this buildings inter-relationship with the railroads is obvious. For many years this building was a bakery and distribution center for the Manbeck Bread Company.



