Description

This is a two story, three bay frame house with a gable roof covered with corrugated steel. There is a shed roofed porch across the front with the original balustrade and chamfered posts. The house has been covered with vinyl siding and is sitting on a stone and block foundation. It is typical of turn-of-the-century vernacular construction in Hancock.
