Description

This is a two story, three bay frame house with a central cross gable. The roofing material is painted slate. Across the front is a porch that has been altered and a two story extension with an addition on the rear. The house has been covered with aluminum siding and is sitting on a rubble stone foundation. It reflects Hancock's building boom of the early 20th century.
