Description

This is a one-and-a-half story frame house. It is a three bay structure with three over one windows arranged in pairs. There is a small porch deck across the second floor front and it has a front walk-in basement entrance. The house has been covered with insul siding and is sitting on a concrete block foundation. This building is typical of the modest frame houses associated with Hancock's construction boom during the first quarter of the 20th century.
