Description

This is a two story L-shaped brick house with a gable roof covered with three-tab asphalt shingles. It has four bays at the front elevation with one over one windows beneath segmental arches and with stone sills. There is a wrap-around porch across the front and west side which is partially enclosed. An old, 19th century stone retaining wall along the highway was rebuilt in front of this house, possibly in the 1920s or 1930s. This house is part of Hancock's expansion and growth period of the early 20th century.
