Description

The structure is a two story brick commercial building with a flat built-up roof. It has an addition on the front with several new glass sliding doors and a full view door. There is a second story side porch on the east side, the brick work is Flemish bond and the second floor windows have brick segmented arches. Although substantially altered this building represents the commercial development at the east end of Hancock during the early 20th century.
