Description

This structure is a two story, three bay, gable fronted brick house. It has two over two windows jack headers and stone sills. There is a hip roofed porch across the front that has been altered and a small porch on the rear. It is typical of the modest housing erected during Hancock's construction boom in the early 20th century.
