Description

This is a one-and-a-half story, three bay frame or log house with a gable roof punctuated by two dormers. There is a two bay shed extension to the west. Across the front is a raised porch with square posts. The house is covered with stucco, aluminum siding and insul brick siding on the exterior, and rests on stone foundations. This may be a mid-late 19th century log house of the type found along the National Pike in western Maryland.
