Description

This is a two-and-a-half story, three bay frame or log house with a gable roof covered with three-tab asphalt shingles. There is a raised porch across the front and west side, both have been altered. The house has been covered with asbestos siding and is sitting on a rubble stone foundation. It has a walk-in front side basement. This may be a modified mid or late 19th century log dwelling of the type found along the National Pike in western Maryland.
