Description

This is a two story frame house with Queen Anne influence. It has intersecting gable roofs covered with rolled roofing. It is a five bay structure with one over one windows. There is a wrap-around porch with the original balustrade and columns. The house has been covered with aluminum siding and is sitting on a rubble stone foundation. The house appears on the 1908 Sanborn map, and is part of Hancock's development boom of the early 20th century.
