Description

This is a two story, six bay log house with a gable roof covered with corrugated steel. Across the front is a two story porch with late 19th century details, including fancy balustrades, chamfered posts, brackets and gingerbread. The house has the original lapped siding on the front elevation and is sitting on a rubble stone foundation. The house appears on the 1908 Sanborn Insurance map and the 1877 Atlas map. This house is significant as/or presenting the early-mid 19th century appearance of Hancock of which few examples remain.
