Description

This is a two story, two bay frame or log house with a gable roof covered with three-tab asphalt shingles. The first floor has a 1950s picture window. The house has been extensively altered, windows changed and the exterior is covered with asbestos siding. It is sitting on a rubble stone foundation. The house appears on the 1908 Sanborn map and may be on the 1877 Atlas map. It is typical of mid-late 19th century construction along Hancock's main street.


