Description

This house is a two-and-a-half story log house. The roof structure has a dormer on the front side. It is a four bay structure on the ground floor, with one over one window pane units. There is a second floor wrap-around porch with gingerbread trim. The exterior is covered with German siding and aluminum siding. The house has been greatly altered - windows, doors and it may be two houses made into one. It does appear on the 1908 Sanborn map and the 1877 Atlas map. The western three bays are a gable fronted addition, probably dating from about 1900.
