Description

This is a brick commercial bank building with Classical Revival influences. It is a three bay structure with fixed pane window units, the windows have key-stone lintels. The cornice has original details, brackets and modillions. The building does appear on the 1923 Sanborn maps. It is representative of the commercial and residential boom period of the early 20th century in Hancock.
