Description

This is a three story, three bay brick building with a large inside end chimney. The gable roof is covered with three-tab asphalt shingles. It is a commercial and residential structure with early 20th century fixed pane storefront units. Although altered, this building appears to be among Hancock's earlier surviving buildings and represents its early-mid 19th century appearance. The storefront is an old modification.
