Description

This is a two story brick commercial and residential structure, gable roofed with front dormers and covered with corrugated steel. It has a three bay commercial storefront with fixed pane units, upper windows are one over one units. There is a frame extension to the east with a sei-hexagonal projecting bay. Although extensively altered, this building is one of Hancock's pre-20th century structures and suggests the town's 19th century appearance.
