Description

This is a two story late Queen Anne brick house with a gable front. It is a four bay structure with one over one window pane units and a semi-hexagonal projecting bay beneath a gable. Across the front is a porch with brick piers. The exterior is brick and it does appear on the 1908 Sanborn map. It is representative of Hancock's construction boom during the early 20th century.
