Description

This is a two story brick house with a gable front embellished with a pent roof. It is a five bay structure with six over one window pane units. There is a second floor semi-hexagonal projecting bay. Windows have stone headers and sills. This building does appear on the 1908 Sanborn map. It reflects Hancock's major construction boom of the early 20th century.
