Description

This is a two story, five bay frame or log and masonry building with a gable roof covered with standing seam metal. It has six over six windows and recent fixed window pane units. It has been altered extensively with its storefront windows, asbestos siding and it sits on a rubble stone foundation. It appears to be a two part building and is one of Hancock's older standing structures, reflective of the mid 19th century.
