Description

This is a one-and-a-half story frame house with a central cross gable. It is a two bay structure with one over one window pane units. Across the front is a 1970s enclosed porch. The exterior is covered with aluminum siding and the house sits on a poured concrete foundation. The house may appear on the 1908 Sanborn map, and represents Hancock's major growth and development period which occurred in the early 20th century.
