Description

This is a two story frame or log house with a gable roof covered with asphalt shingles. It is a three bay structure with one over one new windows. Across the front is a two story porch. The exterior is covered with aluminum siding and the house sits on a brick foundation. It appears on the 1908 Sanborn map. As a late 19th century structure, this building although altered represents the appearance of Hancock just prior to the major construction boom of the early 1900s.
