Description

This is a two story frame house with some Eastlake influences. There are projecting gable roofs covered with standing seam metal. It is a three bay structure with one over one and fifteen over one window pane windows. The exterior is covered with wood siding and the house sits on a stone foundation. It has many original details and four projecting bays. The house does appear on the 1908 Sanborn map, and reflects Hancock's commercial and residential boom of the early 20th century.
