Description

This is a two story, three bay frame or log house with a projecting dormer. It has one over one windows. Across the front is a porch with some original gingerbread details - balustrades, posts and brackets. The exterior is covered with wood siding and the house sits on a rubble stone foundation. As a 19th century building, this house reflects Hancock's earlier appearance prior to the major construction phase of the early 20th century.
