Description

This is a two story brick commercial building with a gable front roof covered with asphalt shingles. It is a four bay structure with fixed pane storefront windows and one over one windows on the second floor. The building has a rubble stone foundation, and appears on the 1908 Sanborn map. It is part of a row of late 19th century commercial buildings that reflect Hancock's appearance at the end of the 19th century.
