Description

This is a two story, two part brick commercial and residential building with a gable roof covered with asphalt shingles. It is a six bay structure with fixed pane storefront windows and one over one upper windows. Brick chimneys are located inside each gable end. The building appears to be a two-part structure and reflects Hancock's appearance in the 19th century prior the major construction boom of the early 20th century. During the Civil War this was Dr. Deleplaine's residence and office.
